 istrators by their presents and grant do and with the said James
 Jones his heirs and assigns that they do quit all claim right
 or title to the said land and relinquish the same unto James Jones
 and to his heirs forever and also will by their presents warrant
 and forever defend all right title claim or demand of any
 person or persons claiming or demanding the same or any part
 or part thereof — In Witness whereof the said Henry
 Jones and Elizabeth his wife both here sit their hands
 and affix their seals this day and date as before written.
