This Indenture was acknowledged by James Muller party here
in pursuance of an act of assembly in such case made and provided
and admitted to record - And also a writ here for the said County of
Southampton the 15th day of May 1815 This Indenture was
recorded upon the first ending of the day - Teste J. Rockwell C.

This Indenture made this first day of May in the year of
our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen - between Lewis
P. Hart of the town of Jerusalem of the one part John Vagubart
of the county of Southampton and Enock Rayner of the state of
North Carolina of the second part and James Rockwell of the town
of Jerusalem of the third part - Witnesseth that Where as said
Lewis P. Hart stands justly indebted to the said Enock Rayner the
sum of One hundred and ninety four dollars and nine cents and being
willing and desirous to secure the said Vagubart and Rayner the
payment of the said sums as stated above with lawful interests
thereon from the date hereof and for the further consideration
of five dollars to him the said Lewis P. Hart in hand paid by

by the said James Rockwell trustee for the parties to this said
Lewis P. Hart, does hereon and hereby make over convey & confirm
unto him the said trustee James Rockwell the four following Slaves
to wit Jack Henry Louisa and King To have hold and possess
in full and complete right the said four slaves in trust nevertheless
upon this condition that if the said Lewis P. Hart his heirs or
or assigns shall fail delay refuse to pay or cause to be paid unto the
said J. Vagubart and the C. Rayner their dues or or assigns the
aforesaid sums of money severally due to them as above stated
and lawful interest thereon at or upon the first day of January
next 1816 that then and in that case it shall be lawful and
