 trust at public sale after twenty days notice by advertise-
 ment and out of the money arising from the sale which is
 to be made for cash first to pay to the said Virgibart and
 Rayner then just claims the expense of recording & executing
 this deed of trust and the surplus if any to be paid to the
 said Lewis P. Hart or his legal representative and the said
 Virgibart and Rayner and the said James Rockwell trustees
 do hereby covenant and agree that if the said debts and
 interest be paid as as to render a sale of the said slaves un-
 necessary that they will release all right and interest
 in and to the slaves acquired by this indenture in Wm.
 Witnes whereof the said Lewis P. Hart and James Rockwell
 have here put their hands and seals the day and year first
