This indenture was acknowledged by Nath^t Foster
party unto his appearance of an act of assembly by such cause or cause
and provided and with a commission for the private examination
of W^m Harriet Foster and a certificate of his execution returned and
sworn to record And at a court held here for the said County
of Southampton the 15th day of May 1815 This indenture was
entered upon the proceedings of the day Test^r James Rockwell

This Indenture made this third day of February one thousand
eight hundred and fifteen between Benjamin Johnson of the county of
Southampton and state of Virginia of the first part Thomas Vaughan
son of the same county and state the second part and John T Blow
of the same county and state mutually chosen by the parties of parts
as their trustee of the third part - Witnesseth that a sum of Thomas
Vaughan - now became bound in a note as security for the said
Benjamin Johnson to John Thomas executor of James Blow deceased
for the sum of two hundred and eight dollars and six cents bearing
date the third day of February one thousand eight hundred and fifteen
payable on the first day of January one thousand eight hundred and
sixteen and the said Benjamin Johnson honestly deserves to secure unto
him the said Thomas Vaughan and for and in consideration of the
just and full sum of one dollar to him the said Benjamin Johnson
is and paid by the said John T Blow at or before the sealing
and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof be the said Benj^m
Johnson both hereby acknowledge and for every part thereof doth
acquit and discharge him the said John T Blow his executors
Administrators heirs the said Benjamin Johnson I have granted bargained
and sold unto him the said John T Blow his heirs and assigns
forever all that meadowes tenement of land containing one hundred
and forty five acres more or less in the said the said Benjamin Johnson
now resides business by the hands of Joshua Johnson Martha Foster
and A Parker and all houses woods meadows waters and watercourses
to have and to hold unto him the said John T Blow his heirs
and assigns forever - In trust nevertheless and this Indenture is
upon this express Condition that he the said John T Blow or his
heirs at any time after the first day of February one thousand
