This Indenture made this 11th day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fiftieth between Thomas and Joshua Buttlow and Mary Denson of the one part and Jeremiah Soyner of the other part all of Southampton County - Whereas by an Indenture bearing date the 30th of July eighteen hundred and six between the said Jeremiah Soyner and Jordan Denson deceased of the County aforesaid he the said Jeremiah Soyner did therein and thereby for securing the payment of the sum of three hundred and sixty eight dollars 25 cents he then and there stood indebted unto the said Jordan Denson with lawful interest arising thereon conveyed by way of mortgage unto the said Jordan Denson and to his heirs forever the fee simple estate of in and to a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the said County of Southampton But nevertheless the said Conveyance so as aforesaid made by a purchase thereunto subjoined was to be entirely paid for all intents and purposes as if the same had never been made upon the said Jeremiah Soyner paying unto the said Jordan Denson the said debt and interest thereupon arising and becoming due as by the said Indenture yet remaining of record in the Court of the said County of Southampton reference being thereunto had well now fully paid at large and paid and whereas the said Jeremiah Soyner hath well and truly paid unto the said Thomas Buttlow Joshua Buttlow and Mary Denson the lawful heirs of Jordan Denson deceased
