We James Harris and David Myrick Justices of the peace in the County aforesaid in the state of Virginia do hereby certify that Rebecca Williams the wife of Trencher Williams parties to a certain deed for the conveyance of real estate to Jacob Williams bearing date on the 29th day of August 1800 and fourpence and three annexe personally appeared before us in our County aforesaid and being examined by us privately and apart from her husband and having the deed aforesaid fully explained to her she the said Rebecca Williams acknowledged the same to be her act and deed and declared that she had willingly signed sealed and delivered the same and that she wished not to retract it — Given under our hands and seals this 13th day of May 1815 —
