Know all men by these presents that I William G Britt of
the County of Southampton for the natural love and affection which
I bear to my brother Jesse Britt of the aforesaid County as well as
for the further considerations of twenty five cents to me in hand
paid by the said Jesse Britt on delivery of these presents the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged have given and granted and by these
presents do give and grant unto him the said Jesse his heirs and
assigns a certain piece or parcel of land lying and being in the
aforesaid County of Southampton and bounded as followeth to wit
Beginning at an oak in the south east corner of John Britt's line
thence easterly by a line of fence and chopt trees across said William
G Britt's land to Matthew Williams line thence along said
Williams line to Nathan Britt's line thence along said Nathan
Britt's line to said Jesse Britt's old crop line thence along said
