Gray was and his estate is still bound as security with the legal interest which may have accrued thereon and the aforesaid sum of one hundred and fifty pounds due from the said Edwin Gray Esq. to Daniel Herring by bond bearing date the 10th day of November 1810 wherein the said Henry M. Gray was and his estate is still bound as security and the legal interest which may have accrued thereon also all debts where the said Henry M. Gray was and his estate is still bound as security for the said Edwin Gray Esq. and all sums which may be due owing from the said Edwin Gray Esq. to the estate of said Henry M. Gray deceased and the surplus if any shall remain after defraying the expences of executing this trust pay over to the said Edwin Gray Esq. His heirs executors or administrators to have and to hold the aforesaid trust or parcels of land with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said Edwin Gray Esq. His heirs executors administrators or assigns forever in testimony whereof the parties hereto have set their names and affixed their seals the day and year above written.
