This Indenture made this twenty eighth day of August
 in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and
 fifteen between Christopher Rivers deputy of Jacob Dason
 sheriff of the County of Southampton on behalf of the Common-
 wealth of Virginia of the one part and Joshua Fort of the
 County of Southampton and state aforesaid of the other part
 Witnesseth that whereas the said Christopher Rivers deputy
 sheriff of the County of Southampton aforesaid by virtue of an
 act of the general assembly of the Commonwealth of Virginia
 passed on the 9th day of February 18th entitled "an act to amend
 explain the act entitled an act concerning taxes on lands" hath
 exposed to sale so much of a tract of land returned delinquent
 in the County of Southampton for the non payment of taxes
 thereon for the years 1809, 1811, 1812, as will be sufficient to
 discharge the arrears of taxes for the aforesaid years with two
 per cent per year damage thereon and the said Joshua
 Fort he and the purchaser of two and a half acres for the sum
 of thirty five cents being the amount of taxes and seven ages due
 thereon to him the said Christopher Rivers deputy Sheriff as
 aforesaid doth hereby acknowledge hath bargained and sold
 and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said
