

This Indenture made the 15th day of February in the
 William Williams of our lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and fifty
 between James Williams and Elizabeth Williams his wife of the
 County of Southampton and parish of Stotting of the one part
 and William Williams of the same county and parish of the
 other part Witnesseth that the said James Williams and
 Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of three
 hundred and one shillings and seven pence good lawful
 money of England to them in hand paid by the said William
 Williams of the receipt whereof the said James Williams and
 Elizabeth his wife doth acknowledge themselves fully and
 amply satisfied and paid hath granted bargained sold
 aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth give
 bargain and sell unto the said William Williams to him
 his heirs forever one certain tract or parcel of land & premises
 adjoining the said William Williams land lying & being in
 the County of Southampton aforesaid lying as follows Thomas
 Parthen millpond containing by a late survey and division
 made in the lands of Jasper Williams dec^d by the County survey
 ninety acres and one half acres be the same more or less and
 bounded as follows he met beginning at a small black gum on
 Corner of William Williams land standing in a small back
 and now made a new corner of lot N^o 7 and 8 of the division
 of the mill pond tract running thence along the dividing line of
 lot N^o 7 and 8 S 35° East 90 feet to a pine a new corner
 made on the side of Thomas Parthen millpond thence up
 the millpond (and mill pond branch the various courses then
 to a pine a corner of John Davis standing on the side of the
 mill branch thence South 5 East 72 feet to a pine a corner
 of William Williams thence N 72 E 48 feet to a small
 red oak a corner in William Williams land thence S 58 E 38
 feet to a pine a corner of William Williams thence S 31 W 38
 feet thence S 19 E 114 feet to a sweet gum a corner of the
 said William Williams thence N 75° E 26 feet to a
 branch thence N 36 E 14 feet along the same branch
