This Indenture made this 14th day of June in the year one
 thousand eight hundred and fourteen between Jeremiah
 Johnson and Lucetta his wife of Southampton County Virg:
 of the one part and Humphrey Drury of said County of
 the other part Witnesseth that the said Jeremiah Johnson
 and Lucetta his wife for and in consideration of the sum
 of two hundred and twenty three and a third dollars to them
 in hand paid by the said Humphrey Drury the receipt
 whereof is hereby fully acknowledged hath given granted
 bargained sold confirmed and made over and by these
 presents doth give grant bargain sell confirm and make
 over unto the said Humphrey Drury his heirs and assigns
 forever one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and
 being in the County aforesaid and bounded as follows—
 Beginning at a red oak standing in the deep branch thereof
 a North Course along Cole Thomas Ridgelys line to a white
 oak standing in Thomas Ridgelys line a corner tree then a
 along said Ridgelys line to a red oak standing in said Drury
 line a corner tree thence a South Course along said line to a
 white oak standing in Harris Johnsons line a corner tree
 thence a West Course along said Johnsons line to the beginning
 containing by last survey sixty seven acres be the same now
 or late To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land
 with all the appurtenances thereof unto the said Humphrey
 Drury his heirs and assigns forever together with all
