This Indenture made this twentieth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen between Richard E Williams and Patsy his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Neal Waddell of the same County and State aforesaid of the other part— Witnesseth that the said Richard E Williams and wife for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand twenty nine and three fourths dollars to them in hand paid at and before the signing and delivery of this presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and the said Richard E Williams and wife therewith satisfied contented and peace hath bargain sold aliened conveyed and confirmed unto the said Neal Waddell his heirs and assigns one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and as known and distinguished by the Johnson Land's lying that part that was assigned to Elizabeth Wick as her dower right which has been purchased by the said Williams of Elizabeth Wick as Reference to her deed of sale bearing date the seventh day of February one thousand eight hundred and fifteen containing by a well surveyed made by James Jones forty eight and a half acres be the same more or less Together with all Censures Gardens orchards meadows woods and watercourses mines
