 Five hundred and nineteen dollars 99 cents Current money of
 Virginia to him in hand paid by the said John V. V.
 and one dollar by the said William Bailey True to the receipt
 whereof he doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained
 and sold conveyed and confirmed and doth by these presents
 grant bargain sell alien enfeoffed and confirm unto the said
 William Bailey and to his executors and administrators and to the
 heirs and assigns of both of them (residues) which he inherited from his
 father Matthew Brith under his last will and testament
 also the two undivided parts of land which the said Joseph
 Brith has this day bought of his brother Benjamin Brith
 and Merit Brith unless appear by the deeds executed by
 them to the said J. Brith before the signing and delivery
 of this deed containing by estimation one hundred and
 fifty acres more or less also one Negro man Peter one Negro
