This Indenture made the twentieth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen between Robert Ricks Sen^r of the County of Southampton of the one part and William Ricks sen^r of the said Robert Ricks of the other part Witnesseth that the said Robert Ricks for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which he to the said Robert Ricks beareth to the said William Ricks and for the further consideration of eleven pounds current money to him the said Robert Ricks paid by the said William Ricks the receipt to have of is hereby acknowledging that the Robert Ricks hath given granted aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant enfeoff and confirm unto the said William Ricks his heirs and assigns all and singularly the two following tracts of land and the appurtenances therewith belonging or in any way appertaining to and one tract purchased by the said Robert Ricks of Benjamin Drew as well appear in a deed executed and recorded in the County Court of Southampton bearing date the 2nd day of August between Thomas Moore 1802 containing six hundred and twenty six acres more or less situated lying and being in the County of Southampton on the north side of Ricks River swamp and bounded as follows beginning at the mouth of the Ricks branch thence up the said branch the various corners thereof be a corner pine in said Drews line formerly belonging thence along the said Drews line S 68^o W 133 feet to a corner pine of Thomas Moore dec^d line thence along the said Moore line S 21 W 72 feet to a red oak thence S 55 E 66 feet to a pine on the side of the old road thence along the old road
