This Indenture made this 20th day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen between Rebecca McCormac of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and Thomas E. Brooks of this County and state aforesaid, of the other part Witnesseth that the said Rebecca McCormac for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars to her in hand paid by the said Thomas E. Brooks she receipt whereof the said Rebecca McCormac with herely acknowledge have granted bargain and sold and confirmed and by their presents do grant bargain and sell alien and confirm unto the said Thomas E. Brooks his heirs and assigns forever all that messuage or tenement situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and wherein the said Rebecca McCormac now lives containing forty seven acres more or less reference being had to the deed from Benjamin Weston to the said Rebecca McCormac the bounds of which will appear fully and also the names of the messuages and messuages and messuages and services of the said land and every part thereof
