This Indenture made this twenty third day of September
 in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and sixty five
 between Howell Myrick deputy of Jacob Darden Sherriff
 of the County of Southampton in behalf of the Commonwealth
 of Virginia of the one part and William Perkins of the County
 of Sussex and state aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth
 that whereas the said Howell Myrick deputy of Jacob Darden
 Sherriff of Southampton aforesaid by virtue of an act of the
 general assembly of the Commonwealth of Virginia passed
 the 9th day of February 1864 entitled "an act to amend and
 explain an act entitled an act concerning taxes on lands
 hath exposed to sale so much of a tract of land returned delin-
 quent in the County of Southampton for the non payment of
 taxes thereon for the years 1793 1805-1806 & 1810 as will be
 sufficient to discharge the arrears of taxes for the aforesaid
 years with ten percent per year damages thereon and the said
 William Perkins became the purchaser of ninety two acres
 for the sum of five dollars and forty cents being the amount
 of taxes and damages due thereon and ^{the cost of} executing this deed
 the clerk for to him the said Howell Myrick Deputy of Jacob
 Darden Sherriff as aforesaid in hand paid the
 said Howell Myrick deputy of Jacob Darden Sherriff as of such
 both hereby acknowledged hath bargained and sold and by
 these presents do bargain and sell unto the said William Perkins
 his heirs and assigns a certain piece or parcel of land contain-
 ing ninety two acres being a tract or parcel of land returned
 ninety two acres returned delinquent for the non payment of
 taxes thereon in the name of Joseph Phillips for the years
 aforesaid together with all and singularly the appurtenances
 thereto belonging reversions and reversions remainder and
 annuities rents issues and profits thereof and of every
