This Indenture and Certificate of James Jones and David Myrick magistrates of the County Certifying the return Judgment of William Worrell and Sarah his wife Mary Worrell and Sarah his wife and Estith Council parties hereto in pursuance of an act of assembly in such case made and provided and admitted to record— was at a Court held for the said County of Southampton the 25th day of November 1815 This Indenture and Certificate as aforesaid were entered upon the proceedings of the day

This Indenture made this twentyfirst day of June one thousand eight hundred and fifteen between Edward Barrow of the County of Southampton state of Virginia of the one part and a Nicholas Cobb of the said County and state of the other part Witnesseth that the said Edward Barrow for and in consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Nicholas Cobb the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and for other good causes him moving have bargained and sold unto the said Nicholas Cobb his heirs executors and assigns all that tract of land wherein the said Nicholas Cobb now lives containing one hundred and forty acres more or less and bound as is called of trust executed to me by the said Nicholas Cobb to secure upon barrow his security for the sum of thirty four pounds eleven shillings and to deliver me with its interest To have and to hold that said tract of land with all the appurtenances thereon or thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to him the said Nicholas Cobb forever and with the said Edward Barrow with his heirs and assigns unto the said Nicholas Cobb the said land as above mentioned from any claim or demand concerning the said land
