This Indenture made this 20th day of April
in year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen
between Jeremiah Cobb Richard E Williams John Moore
and Benjamin Devany Commissioners appointed by the Court
of Southampton to make sale of the tract of land
conveyed by James Mellican to the heirs of William Morris
decd. of the one part and Abel Maddell of the County of
Southampton of the other part Witnesseth that the said
Commissioners for and in consideration of the sum of seven
hundred and ten dollars and four cents to them in hand
paid by the said Abel Maddell the receipt whereof the
said Commissioners doth hereby acknowledge they the said
Commissioners have granted and sold and by these presents
do grant and sell alien and confirm unto the said Abel
Maddell his heirs and assigns forever all that said
messuage or tenement situate lying and being in the
County of Southampton and containing by estimation two
hundred and eighty acres of land ^{the said Morris decd.}
more fully appears and all the reversion and reversions
rents and services of the said premises and every other part
thereof
