Know all men by these presents that I Martha Clements of the County of Southampton for and in Consideration of the natural love and Affection which I bear to Moses Clements of the aforesaid County as well as for the further Consideration of fifty dollars to me in hand paid by the said Moses Clements at or before the making and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have given and granted and by these presents doth give and grant unto the said Moses Clements his ex^{ors} Administrators & assigns the following property to wit -
