hundred thousand eight hundred and fifteen between John Shuck &  
Sally his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Jesse  
Tucker of the County of Sussex of the other part, Witnesseth that the said  
John Shuck & Sally his wife for and in consideration of the sum of  
seventy three dollars and fifty cents lawful money of Virginia to them in Law  
paid by the said Jesse Tucker before the making and delivering of these  
presents the receipt whereof they acknowledge John Shuck & Sally his wife  
do hereby acknowledge theirself and every part thereof doth fully and  
clearly and lawfully acquit exonerate & discharge the said Jesse Tucker
