

A parish of a battery and bounded as follows to west beginning at a
 black oak standing in the field, low then walking the said line
 east forty seven poles to a black post thence West twelve poles to a
 pine then a still west three poles to a white oak thence twenty five poles
 to a pine thence seven poles to a white oak three more poles to a white
 oak three forty five poles to a white oak three seven poles to a pine
 thence nineteen poles to a yellow oak three eleven poles to a pine
 thence east thirty seven poles to a red oak thence thirty eight poles to
 a white oak thence thirty seven poles to a white oak a corner of the
 land formerly belonging to Benjamin Melleons deceased thence along
 the said line east twenty two poles to a white oak a corner of short
 Barns line thence along the said Barns line fifteen poles West
 West thirty poles to a pine thence south six poles east twelve poles
 to a pine thence South fifty one poles east one hundred and fifty six
 to a black oak standing and thence to the first station it being the
 same land wherein said Lewis Drake formerly lived and which said
 land the said Lewis Drake and wife and son conveyed to Samuel Hart
 father to the said Lewis P. Hart party to them presents by deed
 bearing date the 11th day of October 1790 and which descended to said
 Lewis P. Hart party to them presents by the death of his father Samuel
 Hart also one other tract or parcel of land containing by estimation
 thirty acres in the same more or less lying, lying and being situated in
 the parish of Mattaway and County of Southampton on the North
 side of Drayton run swamp and bounded as follows beginning at a
 pine a corner of this tract and Barnaby Drake son of Samuel
 Hart living there a black oak in George Washingtons line thence
 to Washingtons line to a pine a corner this of said tract and said
 Washingtons line leading still on said Washingtons line to a small
 green standing in a branch a corner of William Washington
 thence a line to a pine standing on the main road thence down the said
 road to the first station it being a tract or parcel of land which
 Samuel Hart purchased of Simmons Drake and wife by deed bearing date
 the 10th day of January 1790 and which said land descended to the said
 Lewis P. Hart party to them presents by the death of his father Samuel
 Hart containing in the whole two hundred and eighty four acres in
 the same more or less To have and to hold the aforesaid tracts and
 parcels of land and every of their appurtenances unto him the said
 James Melcher his heirs and assigns forever and the said Lewis P.
