Hunt party here - also in the Clerk's office November 18th 1815 This Instrument was acknowledged by Lewis P. Hunt party here in pursuance of an act of assembly in such case made and provided and admitted to record - And at a Court held for the said County of Southampton the 20th November 1815 The Instrument and Certificate as aforesaid were entered upon the proceedings of the day -

Know all men by these presents that I John Foster of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia for diverse good causes and Considerations me hereunto moving Sheweth also by these presents do the manner and set free and forever disquit claim to all right and title which I have to the Service of Daniel a negro man hitherto held by me in Slavery and do for myself and my heirs relinquish and renounce all power Authority whatsoever over the said negro man Daniel hereby declaring to the world that the said negro man from this day forward is free and entitled to all the rights and privileges which free persons of colour are entitled to and enjoy in this Commonwealth - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 20th day of November one thousand eight hundred and fifteen -
