This Indenture made the 28th day of February in the year of
our lord one thousand eight hundred and thirteen between Wilson Denon
and Susannah Denon his wife of the County of Franklin and state
of North Carolina of the one part and Thomas Britton of the County of
Southampton and state of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth
that the said Wilson Denon and Susannah his wife for and in
consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars good and lawful money
of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Britton the receipt
whereof the said Wilson Denon and Susannah his wife doth acknow-
ledge themselves fully and amply satisfied and paid hath granted has
given sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by their presents doth
grant bargain and sell unto the said Thomas Britton his heirs and
assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land and premises being the
said Wilson Denon and Susannah his wife part of the lands whereon
Edwin Williams did and doth possess lying on the north side of the
Cahoon swamp in the County of Southampton and parcel of the land
containing by a late survey eighty six acres and bounded as follows
to wit beginning at a small green pine which ought to formerly be
a corner or new corner now made in the dividing line between
Britton Harris one of the heirs of the same land and the said
Wilson Denon running thence south 48° East 76 poles to a
black gum a corner of Thomas Britton's land standing in a
small branch thence S. by E. 18 poles to a green pine a new corner
made in the dividing line between Wilson Denon & Edy Williams
