Annually to the within Commission to us directed we have procured to examine the within named Lydia M. Men separately and apart from her husband ifen and to her right to the said tract of parcel land within mentioned who declares she relinquishes her right of dower in the said tract or parcel of land within aforesaid ^{freely} without the persuasion or threats of her said husband and is willing the same should be recorded in the County Book of Southampton Town under our hands & seals this 25th day of March 1814

Also a cert. held for the County of Southampton the 15th day of April 1814 This Indenture was given by the oath of Thomas B. Hunt J. C. L. with a Commissioner for the peace in confirmation of Mrs. Lydia M. Men and a Certificate of its execution ^{remains} and continued and in the books offered to view in 25th 1815 This Indenture was ^{given} by the oath of James Pelland and Anthony Evans two of the Witnesses thereto and admitted to view in pursuance of an act of assembly in each case made and provided and at a Court held for the said County of Southampton the 15th day of December 1816 This Indenture and Certificate as aforesaid were entered upon the record of the day - Seal James Rockwell J. C.

This Indenture made and entered into this 25th day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen between Samuell W. Perkins and Betsey his wife of Suffolk County Henry D. Simeon and Deborah his wife of Southampton County Sherry Suckins and Gray S. Suckins of the one part and William Suckins of the other part Witnesseth that the said Samuell W. Perkins and Betsey his wife Henry D. Simeon and Deborah his wife Sherry Suckins and Gray S. Suckins hath for and in consideration of the sum for her said and twenty dollars to them in Land paid by the said William Suckins the receipt whereof ^{they do hereby acknowledge} they the said Samuell Perkins and Betsey his wife Henry D. Simeon and Deborah his wife Sherry Suckins and Gray S. Suckins hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell the following parcels of land to wit twenty seven square quarter acres lying and being in the County of Southampton and on the east side of the road leading from Allen bridge to Smithfield and a part of that tract on which Jas. A. Perkins formerly lives on Jarvis swamp bounded on the east by the lands belonging to the estate
