of Bedford and state of North Carolina a certain tract or parcel of land in
the said did mentioned and described for a certain purpose which is also
mentioned in the said deed that is to say in trust to secure a debt due
and owing from the said Nathaniel Borman to a certain James Harrison
who also is a party to the said deed of one hundred and seventy nine dollars
and 63 Cents as appears by his note executed for the same bearing equal
date with the said deed and which is also mentioned in the said deed and
whence the said deed was executed for no other purpose design or intent
than that of securing the debt aforesaid and whereas the said debt is
fully discharged and paid by the said Nathaniel Borman to him
the said James Harrison whereof the said James Harrison hath here duly
testified and informed by the said James Harrison Now know ye that
at the said James Harrison for and in consideration of the premises hath
granted released and released and together presents do grant remise and
release to him the said Nathaniel Borman his heirs and assigns
forever all the tract or parcel of land as aforesaid to him conveyed
in trust To have and to hold the said land with its appurtenances
to him the said Nathaniel Borman his heirs and assigns forever
