This Indenture made this first day of December 1815
between Peter B. Pierce of the one part and John Shields of the other
part both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia
Witnesseth that the said Peter B. Pierce for and in Consideration
of the sum of twelve dollars to him in hand paid by the said John
Shields at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents hath
granted bargained sold sold and do by these presents grant bargain
and sell unto the said John Shields a certain lot piece or parcel
of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton on the south
side of the Southfield Road leading from Jerusalem to Smithfield and
immediately opposite the dwelling house of the said John Shields
Containing by survey three acres and bounds as follows to wit
beginning at black gum by the side of the road there a straight
line then each corner to a pine a corner tree thence N 60° a straight
line to a Walnut a corner tree thence N W a straight line to a
sweet gum near the road then up the road to the first station
to have and to hold the said lot piece and parcel of these acres
of land with all and singular the appurtenances thereto in full
