This Indenture made this first day of December 1815 between Recd B. Pence of the one part and John Shields of the other party both of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia witnesseth that the said Recd B. Pence for and in consideration of the sum of twelve dollars to him in hand paid by the said John Shields at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents hath granted bargained and sold and do by these presents grant bargain and sell unto the said John Shields a certain lot piece of land lying and being in the County of Southampton on the west side of the Smithfield Road leading from Jerusalem to Smithfield and immediately opposite the dwelling house of the said John Shields containing by survey three acres and bounded as follows to wit beginning at black ground by the corner of the above mentioned street this line to each corner to a pine a corner tree thence N.E. a straight line to a Walnut a corner tree thence N.W. a straight line to a sycamore tree near the end thereof the road to the first station to him and to hold the said lot piece and parcel of land with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging.
