This indenture was acknowledged by Ben. B. Perce party hereto in pursuance of a writ of Habeas Corpus issued in such case made & provided and as matters to come as to them December 25th 1815 This Indenture and the Certificate of James Jones and Benjamin Griffin magistrates of the aforesaid County certifying the acknowledgment of James Perce the other party hereto and as matters to come as to her and a court held for the said County of Southampton the 15th day of February 1816 This Indenture and Certificate as aforesaid were entered upon the proceedings of the day that James Dockette &

This Indenture made this 25th day of April in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen Benjamin Britte of the County of Southampton of the one part Joshua Fort of the town of Jerusalem of the second part and John Vezubark of the aforesaid County of the other part - Witnesseth that whereas the said Ben Britte stands fully indebted to the said Joshua Fort in the sum of four hundred dollars and hath executed to the said Britte bond for the same due and payable to the said Fort and being willing and desirous to secure to the said Joshua Fort the payment of the said sum of \$400 dollars with interest and for the further consideration of one dollar to one in hand paid by the said John Vezubark Trustee for the parties a hereby make over convey and assign to him the said John Vezubark Trustee all my right title claim demand whatsoever of and to the whole of the tract or parcel of land and the appurtenances thereto belonging which has or may fall to me in possession of the lands of which my father Matthew Britte dies seized and possessed in as full an ample manner as the same can be conveyed by dies being more or less according to the direction which he or may hereafter be made of the said Matthew Britte dec^d land among his heirs to have and to hold to the said John Vezubark Trustee upon trust in the Convention that if the said Ben Britte his heirs executors or assigns should fail delay or refuse to pay or cause to be paid unto the said Joshua Fort his heirs executors or administrators the aforesaid sum of one hundred dollars and lawful interest thereon at or upon the first day of December next that then and in that case it shoud be lawful and full power and authority is hereby given to the said Trustee his certain attorney his heirs executors assigns to sell the said Land and its appurtenances at public sale
