This Indenture made this 25th day of November in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen between
Thomas Cary of the County of Southampton of the first part and
James Rushelle of the town of Jerusalem and County of Loudoun of the
other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas Cary for and in con-
sideration of the sum of twelve hundred and fifty dollars to him in
hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents
the receipt whereof the said Thomas Cary doth hereby acknowledge
and himself and every part thereof doth hereby warrant and defend
the said James Rushelle his heirs executors and administrators
he the said Thomas Cary have granted bargained sold aliened and
conferred and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien
enfeoff and confirm unto the said James Rushelle his heirs and
assigns forever a certain lot of land lying situate and being
in the town of Jerusalem and County of Loudoun and known &
distinguished in the plan of the said town Jerusalem by lot
N^o 5 and bounded as follows beginning at the south east corner
of lot N^o 4 on the West side of the main street thence along the
main street ninety feet four inches to the cross street thence along
the cross street two hundred and thirty seven feet nine inches to the
corner of N^o 6 thence on the line of N^o 6 ninety feet four inches to
the corner of lot N^o 4 thence bounding on lot N^o 4 two hundred
and thirty seven feet nine inches to the beginning also part or parcel
of a certain lot of land lying situate and being in the said town
of Jerusalem and known and distinguished in the plan of the said
town of Jerusalem by N^o 6 bounded as follows beginning at the
south west corner of lot N^o 5 on the north side of the cross street
thence along the line of N^o 5 ninety feet four inches to the corner
of lot N^o 4 thence south seventy six degrees west to a large plane
standing near the river thence down the river to the cross street
thence along the north side of the said street to the beginning
also and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any
wise appertaining and the river and weirs and mill race
and remaining unto all the heirs issues and profits of the said
Land and premises and all his right title and interest
to the same To have and to hold the said lot N^o 5
and the above described parcel or parcel of lot N^o 6 and the
