eight hundred and fifteen between Burrington Arny and Rebecca
his wife formerly Rebecca Mitchell of the County of Brunswick of the
one part and William L. Hote of the County of Lunenburg of the other
part Witnesseth that the said Burrington Arny and Rebecca his
wife formerly Rebecca Mitchell for and in consideration of the sum
of fifty dollars current money of Virginia to them in hand paid
the receipt whereof they the said Burrington Arny and Rebecca his
wife formerly Rebecca Mitchell do hereby acknowledge both granted
hanged and aliened and confirmed and by these presents do grant
conferme all and confirm unto the said William L. Hote his heirs &
assigns forever one certain tract or piece of land containing one hundred
and thirteen acres be the same more or less lying and being in the
County of Southampton no other way never to have the land my wife
Rebecca his, or dower of her first husband Abraham Mitchell.
To have and to hold the above mentioned land and premises with the
appurtenances together with the reversion and reversions and em-
cumbrances thereunto belonging unto him the said W. L. Hote
his heirs and assigns forever and the said Burrington Arny
and Rebecca his wife formerly Rebecca Mitchell for themselves
their heirs &c do covenant and agree unto and with the said William
L. Hote that they the said Burrington Arny and Rebecca his
wife formerly Rebecca Mitchell the above land and premises
with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto
belonging unto him the said W. L. Hote his heirs and assigns forever
