This Indenture and the Certificate of David
Dandor and James Carr magistrates of this County testifying the
acknowledgment of Elizabeth Dandor party here in personance of
her and of a solemnity in this case made and provided and admitted
before the Court here for the said County of Southampton
the 18th day of March 1816. This Indenture as aforesaid were
entered upon the proceedings of the day - Teste
James Dockelle Es

This Indenture made the first day of February one thousand
eight hundred and eighteenth between Ethelred Gardner James Carr and
Arthur Carr Commissioners appointed by the County Court of
Southampton to make sale of the lands belonging to the heirs of
John Glover of the first part and Thomas Lawrence of the other
part witnesseth that the said Ethelred Gardner James Carr and
Arthur Carr Commissioners have set up at public auction
and sold for the sum of seventy five dollars unto the said
Thomas Lawrence twenty five acres of land more or less beginning
at a corner gum standing in Ethelred Gardner's line thence a
straight line of new marked trees to Rosemornal tree stand-
ing in Joshua Gardner's line thence the said Gardner's line to
a pine corner of the said Gardner and from thence a straight
line of new marked trees to a sweet gum standing in Ethelred
Gardner's line and from thence to the first station. To have
and to hold the said bargained premises to him the said Thomas
Lawrence his heirs and assigns forever and we the said Ethelred
Gardner James Carr and Arthur Carr Commissioners do
warrant and defend the said lands so far as we are empowered
by the decree of the said County Court as aforesaid - In Witness
whereof the said Ethelred Gardner James Carr and Arthur Carr
have hereunto set our hands and seals the day and date above
written.
