This Indenture made this 16th day of October in the
year of Christ 1815 between Lucinda Whitehead of the County of
Southampton of the one part and William Story of said County
of Southampton of the other part Witnesseth that the said
Lucinda Whitehead for and in consideration of the sum of one
hundred and fifty dollars Current money of Virginia she here
by the said William Story in hand paid the receipt whereof
the said Lucinda Whitehead doth hereby acknowledge hath
granted bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents doth
grant bargain sell and convey unto the said William Story
his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing
thirty seven acres and an ¹/₄ acre be the same more or less lying
and being in the County of Southampton which land is from
my deceased father John Whitehead and being my portion of a
tract of land also and known by the name of the cedar
piney woods tract which was allotted to me by the Commissioners
daily appointed by the County Court of Southampton of December
Col^d 1814 to make a division of the same but will more fully
appear reference being had to the title N^o in the said Commission
-us report which was returned at February Court 1815 and was
admitted to record in the said County Col^d of Southampton and
bounded as follows to wit beginning in the said lot N^o 4 at a
new corner made in lot N^o 2 and to running due West 90 pole
to a new corner made in lot N^o 5 and of thence S 16 47 52
pole to a new corner made in the out bounds of Capt. Magle's
line a corner of lot N^o 4 and thence North 5 West 70 pole
to the first stational To have and to hold the said lot
