being desirous of selling his interest in the said tract or parcel of
land and being desirous of selling his interest therein now
This Indenture made the fifteenth day of July in the year of
Christ one thousand eight hundred and fifteen between the said
William Tallapoosa and Elizabeth Brownell his wife for and in
consideration of the sum of five hundred and seventy five dollars
to them in hand paid by the said Simon Boykins at or before the
