This Indenture made this twentieth day of February in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and sixteen between Edwin Gray Sen of the first part Edwin Gray Jun of the second part and Thomas Gray of the third part all of the County of Southampton Witnesseth that the said Edwin Gray Jun in order to secure the payment of six hundred and sixty one dollars and nineteen Cents together with the interest to grow due thereon from the 16th day of February one thousand eight hundred & sixteen of lawful money which the said Edwin Gray Jun justly owes to Thomas Gray of the County of Southampton as also to secure the payment of five several bonds which the said Edwin Gray Jun are due to the United States of America for the delivery of certain property that was seized by Howell Myrick deputy of Leake Gordon Sheriff of Sampson the said several bonds bearing date the twenty sixth day of September one thousand eight hundred and fifteen and for the several sums therein after mentioned and are as follows to wit one bond in the penalty of one hundred and eleven dollars and forty four Cents for the payment of fifty five dollars and seventy two Cents second one other bond in the penalty of one hundred and thirty two dollars and two Cents for the payment of sixty six dollars and one Cent Third one other bond in the penalty of one hundred and ninety dollars and twenty two Cents for the payment of ninety seven dollars and eleven Cents Fourth one other bond in the penalty of one hundred and ninety seven dollars and sixteen Cents for the payment of ninety eight dollars and fifty eight Cents Fifth one other bond in the penalty of three hundred and fifty three dollars and fifty Cents for the payment of
