This Indenture made this 10<sup>th</sup> day of September in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifteen between James B. Newsom of Southampton County of the one part and Nathaniel Newsom of the same County of Southampton of the other part Witnesseth that the said James B. Newsom in consideration of the sum of 120 Dollars of lawful money of the Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said Nathaniel Newsom at or before the enrolling and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said Nathaniel Newsom his heirs and assigns his undivided part of the land of which Leo Gathers (Bartham Newsom) did sue and possess containing three hundred and eleven acres by survey to the same more or less lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton in the north side of the poplar swamp and bounded as follows begining at a gum in the great branch a corner in John and Benjamin Myricks line thence along Benjamin Myricks line to the main run of the aforesaid poplar swamp thence up the run of said swamp as it meanders to a corner in William Myricks line thence along said Myricks line to the aforesaid great branch cornering on a maple thence in Amen Myricks line thence down the various corners of
