The Commonwealth of Virginia to William
Summell and James D. Edwards Richard H. Edwards & George Jenkins
gentlemen Justices of the peace for the County of Surry greeting Whereas
Nicholas Faulcon and Sally his wife, by their last and last of
bargain and sale bearing date the third day of January 1815 have
sold and conveyed unto Simon Boykin of the County of Southampton
all their right title and interest of in or to a certain tract or piece of
land situate to the heirs of Martha R. Henry by her death, with the
appurtenances lying and being in the County of Southampton and whereas the
said Sally Faulcon cannot conveniently travel to our County Court of South-
ampton to make acknowledgment of the said conveyance, Therefore we do
give to you or any two or more of you power to receive the acknowledgment
which the said Sally Faulcon shall be willing to make before you of
the conveyance aforesaid contained in the said instrument which is hereto
annexed: and do therefore command you that you do personally go to the
said Sally Faulcon and receive her acknowledgment of the same and
examine her privately and apart from the said Nicholas Faulcon her
husband whether she doth the same freely and voluntarily without
persuasion or threat and whether she be willing that the same shall
be recorded in our County Court of Southampton aforesaid and when you
have received her acknowledgment and examined her as aforesaid that you
distinctly and openly certify us thereof in our said County Court under
your seals: returning then there the said instrument and this writ.
