Whereas the said James Ketcher hath become jointly bound with the
said Lewis B Hart as his security in several sums of money to wit the
sum of one hundred and seventy dollars and fifty seven cents due to
Benjamin Cobb executor of John Turley deceased by bond bearing date the
17th day of June 1815 taken in pursuance of an act of the General
assembly passed the 25th day of November 1814 entitled an act concerning
Executions and for other purposes the further sum of two hundred &
thirty four dollars and fifty cents due to William Phillips executor of
Elizabeth Schell deceased for the benefit of Gray & Dunn by bond bear-
date the 17th day of June 1815 taken in pursuance of the above recited
act of assembly - The further sum of one hundred and sixty dollars &
seventy five cents due to Elizabeth Gardner for the benefit of Abraham
Gardner by bond bearing date the 17th day of June 1815 taken in
