This Indenture made this 3rd day of November 1814 between
George Edwards Sen^r of the County of Nash and state of North Carolina
of the one part and Newell Edwards Sen^r of the County of Southampton
and state of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that the said
George Edwards Sen^r for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred
and twenty five dollars to them in hand paid by the said Newell
Edwards Sen^r the receipt whereof the said George Edwards doth hereby ac-
knowledge hath granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and confirmed
and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien convey confirm
unto the said Newell Edwards his heirs and assigns forever an certain
tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton
containing by estimation seventy five acres more or less and bounded as
follows to wit beginning at a Post a new corner made in lot N^o 5
and standing on the side of the road running thence North 48 E 50 poles
to where the back bounds of lot N^o 4 strikes off from the road thence along
the road to a gum a corner of Richard Blow thence South 71st E 440 poles to
a gum a corner in John Vicks line thence S 4 E 30 poles to a oak
a new corner made in David Newsoms lot N^o 5 thence S 85 W 210
poles to the first station at being a tract or undivided of land which
descended to the said George Edwards by the death of his brother Benjamin
Edwards reference being here to the report of the Commissioners for the
division and allotment of the lands whereof said Benjamin Edwards
did seize and possessed the same well fully and at large appears
To have and to hold the said parcel and descend of land with all its
appurtenances to him the said Newell Edwards Sen^r his heirs and assigns
forever and the said George Edwards Sen^r doth hereby warrant and defend
the title to said land to the said Newell Edwards Sen^r his heirs and assigns
for ever against the claim or claims claim and or demands of him the
said George Edwards his heirs or assigns or any other persons or persons
