This Indenture made this 3rd day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen between William Worrell and Selby his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Cary Worrell of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Worrell and Selby his wife for and in consideration of the sum of thirty five dollars good and lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Cary Worrell the receipt whereof they doth hereby acknowledge themselves fully and amply satisfied and paid hath granted bargained sold alienated released and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release and confirm unto the said Cary Worrell his heirs and assigns forever all that plantation tract or parcel of land and premises with the appurtenances now in the tenure and occupation of the said Cary Worrell situated lying and being in the aforesaid County containing by estimation eight acres sit the same more or less and bounded as follows beginning at a pine a corner tree of Matthew Joiners and said William Worrell thence along a line of marker trees to a pine standing in Gravelly Run of Joseph Harvis thence up said run to black gum in said William Worrell thence a straight line to Matthew Joiners line thence down said Joiners line to the beginning and all houses out-houses edifices buildings yards gardens orchards trees ways waters and watercourses present and
