by the said James Williams the receipt whereof the said Matthew
Williams Elizabeth Williams Zephra Williams and Lucy Williams
doth acknowledge themselves fully and amply satisfied and paid hath
granted bargain sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these
present doth grant bargain and sell unto the said James Williams to
him and his heirs forever and several lots of land which was divided
by virtue of a decree of the County Court of Southampton and in the
state of Virginia aforesaid situate lying and being in the state of
Virginia and County of Southampton aforesaid say lots N^o 1 - 7 acres
lot N^o 2 60 acres lot N^o 3 160 acres by lot N^o 4 160 acres making in
all the number of 452 acres all of which lots were their respective
parts of the lands of Cooper Williams deceased their Father lying in
the state of Virginia and County of Southampton aforesaid and bounded
