

This Indenture made this 29th day of September 1815 between Rich^d Vick of the one part John Fricklow of the second part and James Rochelle of the third part all of the County of Southampton Wiltshire that whereas the said John Fricklow hath become bound with the said Richard Vick in the following sums to wit One bond executed to Richard Arnistead for the sum of two hundred and twenty eight dollars and forty three cents bearing date the 29th day of September 1815 One bond executed to George and Samuel D Hines executors of William Hines deceased who was guardian to Elizabeth H Mitchell for the sum of Ninety five dollars and two cents bearing date the 29th day of September 1815 and other bond executed to Samuel Pasham for the sum of sixty seven dollars and ninety two cents bearing date the 15th day of March 1815 One other bond executed to John Simmons for the sum of seventy nine dollars and eighty two cents dated the 18th day of March 1815 And other bond executed to Lewis A Pasham for the sum of eighty five dollars dated the 18th day of March 1815 One other bond executed to Betsy Woodard adm^o of Samuel Woodard for the sum of thirty one dollars and forty two cents dated the 18th day of March 1815 all of which said bonds were taken in pursuance of an act of assembly entitled an act concerning executions and for other purposes which passed the 25th day of November 1814 and in the further sum of one hundred and six dollars and forty seven cents due by bond called a forthcoming bond executed to George Gurley executor of Josiah Vick deceased bearing date the 27th of September 1815 the further sum of two hundred and sixty seven dollars and sixty four cents due by forthcoming bond executed to Benjamin Cobb executor of John Simmons deceased dated the 29th day of September 1815 the further sum of one hundred and thirty six dollars and sixty five cents due by forthcoming bond executed to George Gurley executor of Josiah Vick dec^d dated the 27th day of September 1815 the further sum of seventy eight dollars and ninety cents due by forthcoming bond executed to Benjamin Plunt serving adm^o of Samuel and Richard Blow adm^o with the will annexed of Henry Blow deceased bearing date the 29th of September 1815 the further sum of four hundred and fifty seven dollars and three cents due by forthcoming bond executed to George Gurley executor Josiah Vick dec^d dated 29th day of September 1815 and the said Richard Vick being desirous of securing and saving harmless the said John Fricklow on account of his suretyship of said bonds hath agreed to and with the said John Fricklow that a conveyance in trust shall be made to James Rochelle for the purpose aforesaid

Now This Indenture witnesseth that the said Richard Vick for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid but especially for and in consideration of one dollar to him the said Richard Vick in hand paid by the said James Rochelle the receipt whereof the said Richard doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained sold and by these presents doth bargain sell and deliver unto the said James Rochelle his heirs executors administrators assigns the following tract of land to wit the tract of land whereon the said Richard Vick now lives which was devised to him by the testament and last will of
