

Commissioners This Indenture made this 29th day of March one thousand eight hundred and sixteen between Richard E Williams and Benjamin Devany Commissioners of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and Thomas Pritlow of the aforesaid County and state of the other part Witnesseth that the said Richard E Williams and Benjamin Devany Commissioners for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and seventy two dollars to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Pritlow at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they the said Richard E Williams and Benjamin Devany Commissioners doth hereby acknowledge and therof acquit and discharge the said Thomas Pritlow his heirs executors and administrators hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien and assign unto the said Thomas Pritlow and certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and parish of Wottonway Containing eighty six acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows on the East by Wottonway swamp West by Thomas Pritlows line and North by the said Thomas Pritlow line and on the South by the Cabin branch it being a part of the tract of land which Edwin Williams deceased died seized and possessed & known in the division by lot N^o 3 as reference to the decree of the County Court of Southampton bearing date June Court 1815 well more fully appear together with all and singular the edifices buildings & gardens orchards woods ways waters watercourses profits emoluments and incidents reversion and reversions remainder and remainders with issues and service thereof to him the said Thomas Pritlow his heirs and assigns forever and the said Richard E Williams and Benjamin Devany Commissioners for themselves their heirs executors and administrators hereby Covenant to and with the said Thomas Pritlow that they will warrant and defend the title to the said granted and bargained premises unto him the said Thomas Pritlow his heirs and assigns forever by these presents against all and every person and persons whatsoever In Testimony whereof they the said Richard E Williams and Benjamin Devany Commissioners have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and date first before written
