This Indenture made this 19th day of January in the year four less Christ One thousand eight hundred and sixteen between Tatten W Scott of the County of Southampton and parish of Stottoway of the one part and George Camp of the same County and parish aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Tatten W Scott for the consideration of the sum of Fifty two dollars good and lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said George Camp the receipt whereof the said Tatten W Scott doth acknowledge himself fully and amply satisfied and paid hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said George Camp one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County aforesaid containing by a true survey made by the county surveyor thirteen acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a black gum corner of Tatten W Scott and George Camp thence N 34 W 49 pole to a red oak corner of George Camp thence N 41 E 54 pole to a pine corner in George Camp and Scotts line thence S 23 E 26 pole to a pine corner made in Tatten W Scotts line thence S 10 W 49 pole to a small Sassafras a new corner made in a small branch between T W Scott and George Camp thence S 44 W 14 pole to the first station along the said branch together with all houses out houses edifices buildings yards gardens orchards woods waters & water courses whatsoever belonging or in any wise appertaining To have and to hold the same to the said George Camp to him and his heirs forever and the said T W Scott for himself has here and assigns doth by these presents covenant and grant to and with the said G Camp that he will by these presents warrant and forever defend all right title claim or demand of any person or persons claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof — In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this day and date within written —
