 very of these presents the receipt whereof the said William Vaughan
 doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained and sold already conveyed
 unto the said Sally Francis and to her heirs and assigns forever one certain
 tract or parcel of land containing forty four acres the the same more
 or less situate and lying in the aforesaid County and parish and bounded
 as follows Vizt by John T Vaughan land Thomas Porter deceased Henry
 B Vaughan and Sally Francis land to have and to hold the said forty four
 acres of land with all and singular the appurtenances thereunto belonging
 to the said Sally Francis her heirs and assigns forever to the only
 proper use and behoof of the said Sally Francis her heirs & assigns
 forever and the said William Vaughan doth for himself & his heirs
 Covenant and agree with the said Sally Francis her heirs and assigns
 that the said William Vaughan his heirs executors & administrators
