Gray of the County of Southampton of the one part and Edwin Gray son of the County of Southampton but now of the County of at the other part Witnesseth that whereas the said Edwin Gray son died on the 22nd day of December one thousand eight hundred and fifteen Convey unto the said John G. Gray two hundred and twenty six acres of land whereon the said Edwin Gray then lived to secure the payment of the sum of three hundred and fifty two dollars and eighty seven cents with the legal interest thereon due and owing to the said John G.
