

Consideration of the premises aforesaid and also for and in Consideration of one dollar by the said Edwin to the said John Gray in hand paid before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John Gray with the Consent of the said John Vaguehart and Daniel Herring signified by their bearing parties hereto have granted remise released and forever quit claim and by these presents do fully and absolutely grant remise release and forever quit claim unto the said Edwin Gray and to the said Thomas Gray and to their heirs and assigns forever all the estate right title interest property claim and demand whatsoever in law or equity of them and each of them the said John Gray John Vaguehart and Daniel Herring of in and to the aforesaid tract of land with its appurtenances to the said Edwin and Thomas Gray their heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Edwin and Thomas Gray their heirs and assigns forever so that the said John Gray John Vaguehart and Daniel Herring nor either of them nor either of their heirs nor any other person whatsoever claiming under them or either of them shall by any way or means hereafter have claim challenge or demand any estate right title or interest of in or to the said premises any part or parcel thereof but from all and every action of the recovery thereof and from all and every estate right title interest or demand of in or to the said premises or any part thereof they and every of them shall be utterly excluded and barred forever by these presents In Witness whereof the parties to these presents have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this day and year first herein written

Indenture made this eighteenth day of March in the year in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixteen by and between Jacob Darden of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and Jesse Parker of the same County and state of the other part Witnesseth that the said Jacob Darden for and in Consideration of four hundred and fifty seven dollars and fifty Cents to him as guardian to Jacob Williams and Leth Williams orphans of Jacob Williams deceased deceased he be paid on or before the first day of May next ensuing the date of these presents by him the said Jesse Parker at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents that the said Jacob Darden for and on behalf of the said Jacob and Leth Williams orphans as well as for himself his heirs executors and administrators shall grant bargain sell alien and confirm and by these presents
