This Indenture made this 4th day of May in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and sixteen between Lewis P Hart and Mary
P Hart his wife of the town of Jerusalem and County of Southampton
of the one part and James Fryant of the parish of Saint Luke and
County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Lewis P
Hart and his wife Mary P Hart and in consideration of the sum of
eight hundred and forty three dollars to them in hand paid by the
said James Fryant the receipt whereof the said Lewis P Hart and
his wife Mary P Hart do hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit the said
James Fryant his heirs executors and administrators have granted bargained
sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents do grant
bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said James Fryant
one certain tract piece or parcel of land which was purchased by
William Hart deceased in his life time of a certain John Blunt as
will appear by referring to a deed of conveyance executed by the said John
Blunt to the said William Hart bearing date the 20th of October 1812
which is duly recorded in the Court of the said County of Southampton and
which was allotted to the said John Blunt by certain Commissioners
appointed by the late high Court of Chancery then in the City of Michin
to divide the lands of Benjamin Edwards deceased according to his last will
and testament and which is devised to the said Lewis P Hart in the
last will and testament of the said William Hart, situate lying
and being in the parish of Saint Luke and County aforesaid on
the North side of Stottoway river containing seventy acres and one
quarter of an acre and known and distinguished in the division
made by the aforesaid Commissioners by lot N^o 11 and is
