that the said Laurence Lock Edmund Turner Farrell Turner for and in
consideration of the sum of six hundred and five dollars and one cent
of lawful money of Virginia to him or have paid by the said Anthony
Woods at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt
whereof the said Laurence Lock Edmund Turner and Farrell Turner
doth hereby acknowledge and thereof and of every part and parcel thereof
doth clearly exonerate acquit and discharge the said Anthony Woods and
his heirs executors administrators and assigns and every of them forever
by these presents to the said Laurence Lock Edmund Turner & Farrell
Turner both granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and confirmed
by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien convey and confirm
forever all that certain tract or parcel of land with the appurtenances
situate lying and being in the County of Southampton containing
one hundred and eighty one acres be the same more or less if such be as
the Contract and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a white oak
tree to a red oak thence east 133 poles to a pine in John Dags line
then along Dags line to Saml Edmunds line thence along Edmunds
line to be shut white oak in the head of a branch then down the
branch still Edmunds line 36 poles to a forked white oak thence
south 4 degrees the south east corner of the young orchards thence
down the open branch to the mouth of the fish pond branch then
up the fish pond branch to the beginning and the reverses & reverses
remainder and remainders of all and singular the said tract or
parcel of land and premises hereby granted or mentioned to be hereby
