This Indenture made this 3rd day of June in the year of our Lord
 Christ one thousand eight hundred and sixteen between Henry B Vaughan
 of the County of Southampton town of Jerusalem and parish of Strolling of the
 one part and John T Vaughan of the same County and parish of Saint Luke of
 the other part Witnesseth that the said Henry B Vaughan for and in consideration
 of the sum of three hundred dollars good and lawful money of Virginia to him in
 hand paid by the said John T Vaughan the receipt whereof the said Henry B
 Vaughan doth acknowledge himself fully and amply satisfied and purchased
 granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and Confirmed and by these presents
 doth grant bargain and sell unto the said John T Vaughan to him and to
 his heirs forever one certain tract or parcel of land and premises containing
 forty four acres being his lot drawn by himself in the division of the lands
 of James Vaughan dec which will fully appear by having reference to the
 plat & report returned to the County Court of Southampton by the County
 surveyor and the Commissioners legally appointed to make the division &
 report and bound as follows to wit beginning at a post oak standing
 near the house in Thomas Porters Estate land and thence bound to John T Vaughan
 lines that he purchased of Thomas Vaughan Jr Samuel Francis Est lines
 William Vaughan lines that he deeded for in the same division afore-
 said and Thomas Porters estate lines to the first station together with all
 houses outhouses edifices buildings yards gardens or charles ways waters & water
 courses whatsoever belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said tract
 of land to have and to hold the same to the said John T Vaughan to
 him and his heirs forever and the said Henry B Vaughan for himself his heirs
 executors administrators and assigns doth by these presents Covenant and grant to &
 with the said John T Vaughan that he well warrant and forever defend
 all right title claim or demand of any person or persons claiming or demanding
 the said land and premises or any part or parcel thereof In Witness whereof the
 said Henry B Vaughan doth hereunto set his hand and affix his seal
 this day of June 1815 before written -
