Know all men by these presents that We William Johnson of the County of Oglethorpe & state of Georgia do for and in Consideration of the sum of fifty dollars to us in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do bargain grant and sell unto James Myrick of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia all right title and claims which we now possess and do possess or ever will possess in the estate of land and negroes of our grandfather Thomas Gelliam which estate is now held and is possession of Calia Champion of Southampton County Virginia as her dower as the wife of our said grandfather dec^d and which said land lays in the said County and state of Virginia and bounded by the lands of George Ober William Butts estate and Nottoway river which said estates were have fallen to us at the death of said Calia Champion as grandchild of said Thomas Gelliam had we not hereby have sold the land and negroes warrant and defend said right title to said Myrick from any claim or claims of any person or persons whatsoever In Witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this day of Oct^r 1815
